Kinder Paint- In this fun-filled painting class, young artists will discover the magic of painting with a variety of colorful materials! Using brushes, sponges, and their hands, kids will explore different painting techniques while creating their own masterpieces.

Around the World- Let's explore art from around the world. There is much to be learned about the different types of art made by different cultures. Students will experience drawing and painting in new and inspiring ways in this class.

Winter Sports-

Mexican Amate Art- Amate Art is vibrant art from Mexico of daily life, nature, and mythical creatures painted on tree bark paper. This class would primarily focus on drawing out the composition and fill in the work using vibrant watercolors and acrylic paints.

Winter Collage- Mixed media at its best! Using colorful paper and paint, create texture and depth to your design. Make your own colorful paper to use in your design, or cut paper from newspapers and magazines. The sky is the limit!

Mixed Media Winter- Discover the fun and fantastic effects of experimenting with and mixing different media. We may try mixing media such as: watercolor, ink, acrylic, pastels, or even creating with unusual materials! Create stunning artwork while learning about drawing, color and composition.

Chinese Inspired Watercolor- This class is ideal for both beginners and advanced students who require guidance with technique, color mixing, and project planning. This class will showcase numerous techniques and demonstrate where they can be used most effectively.

Folk Art (Paint & Clay)- Using mixed media techniques students will recreate Folk art in clay and paintings. Folk Art achieves the power of storytelling through images strongly connected to the natural environment of a culture. These inspiring stories will not only serve us in our recreations but can bring light into our own paintings.

Painting Impressionism- Using French Impressionist artists as our muse we will recreate some of the works from Claude Monet, Edouard Manet, and Paul Cezanne. We will be practicing the rapid brush stroke technique to build up texture as well as atmospheric perspective.

Paper Mache Masks- Masks from different cultures are made to celebrate a variety of topics. Learn about how to create a 3D mask using paper mache.

Ancient Clay Pots- -In this class students will find inspiration from many references to create their very own hand built clay pot. Carefully choosing colors, design, and texture to reflect historical influences.

Olympic Poster Illustrations- Learn how to design your own poster based on the Winter Olympic . See what it takes to incorporate words and images to captivate the audience.

Sports Flip Book- Watch your images come to life as we create mini flipbooks! Learn how easy it is to create motion through a series of cartoons.

Reverse Portrait Collage- Lets learn what it takes to make a self portrait in reverse. This is a great technique for young students to understand the concepts of painting and drawing in a step by step class.
