

## **Class Descriptions**

### **Ages 4-6**

**World of Imagination-** In this class students will follow along the drawing and painting process to create their own beautiful paintings. Students will learn shapes, tracing techniques, and mixing colors.

**Melting Marbles in Clay-** Students will be led through clay projects where they will learn techniques such as coiling, slab, and pinch pots. After the projects are finished we will place glass marbles into the soft clay. These shiny marbles melt in the kiln firing and create beautiful color and textures on the pieces.

**Clay Magic-** Get ready for a hands-on magical adventure in this fun and creative clay class for PreK students! In this engaging class, young artists will have the opportunity to sculpt and mold their very own creations using clay. All pieces will be underglaze on the last day of class and will be given a pick up date.

**Paint Party-** We love to paint! Summer Camp fun starts here with a colorful and creative painting class. Explore a variety of mediums for maximum fun!

### **Ages 7+**

**Clay Creations-** Students will be led through a project using hand building techniques in terracotta clay. This class shows the students techniques and rules of clay to one day construct their own pieces. All pieces will be underglaze on the last day of class and will be given a pick up date.

**Paint Possibilities-** Do you love to paint? This class is perfect for you! This class will explore tempera, watercolors, and acrylic paints to begin to understand each medium and how they work.

**Plaster Painting-** This step-by-step class begins with a 3D construction of the painting using plaster strips. On top of the risen “drawing” students will paint the scene using acrylic paints. This process allows students to get a true understanding of depth and texture in their paintings.

## Ages 10+

**Anime & Manga-** Manga are comics or graphic novels originating from Japan. Most manga conform to a style developed in Japan in the late 19th century, and the form has a long history in earlier Japanese art. The term manga is used in Japan to refer to both comics and cartooning

**Imagine it? Draw it!-** What if your landscapes, still-lives, and portraits had something more going on in them than what you first see? Expand your imagination as you incorporate fantastical images into your drawings and paintings.

**Digital Art-** Using an iPad Pro, stylus, and tools from various art software, students learn art techniques that show why the world of digital art takes creative expression to a new level.

**Weaving with Carla-** Weaving is a fundamental textile technique and has the ability to create decorative items such as tapestries, wall hangings, and placemats. Learn how to interlace beautiful yarn to create a one of a kind work of art! The very talented Mrs Carala will show different patterns to create a decorative hanger.
