4:00-5:30 Unique Animals: From Axolotls to Zebu with Ms Elizabeth (Grade 3 and up) What is the wackiest animal you can think of? Unusual, cool animals like narwhals and sloths and platypuses and other special animal friends will be subjects of this animal portrait class. Draw and paint a menagerie of marvelous creatures!

Tuesday

9:30-11:00 I Love to Paint: Mom and Me with Ms Edith (Age 3-4 with Parent) Using watercolor, tempera, and more, moms and kiddos will have a blast learning about brushwork, mixing colors and creating textures. A nurturing environment to encourage your budding artist's creativity and imagination.

12:30-2:00 POP! Art Party with Ms Carmella (Age 4-6) Using works from Andy Warhol, Jasper Johns, Jeff Koons, Robert Indiana (and others) as our inspiration we will create our own works of art using brush and ink, and a variety of painting mediums. These abstract and pop art works will be filled with bold images and colors!

4:00-5:30 Weaving, Warp & Weft with Ms Carla (Grade 5 and up) Learn one of the oldest artforms in history. Weaving has been around for 12,000 years going all the way back to the neolithic era. Students in this class will create their own lap loom, learn a variety of terms and techniques, and weave their own totally unique tapestry

4:00-5:30 Creative Construction in Paper Mache with Mr Doug (Grade 3 and up) This class is about building dimension to your art! Enjoy learning about different 3D medias like paper clay and plaster gauze. Explore and create beautiful works of art using a variety of subject matter for inspiration!

Wednesday

12:30-2:00 Mix It Up with Ms Edith (Age 4-6) Creating colors was never this much fun! This class is designed to introduce your artists to beginning color theory concepts. Kids will learn how to make secondary colors from primary red, blue, and yellow. We will mix colors and combine paints and other mediums to create colorful art!

4:00-5:30 I Love to Paint: Sweet Treats with Ms Edith (Grade K-2) Budding painters will love this hands-on class! Using watercolor and tempera, students will learn all about brushwork, mixing colors and creating textures, as they develop imaginative paintings of all different subjects! Projects will not repeat and students can take this class over and over again.

4:00-5:30 Meet me at the Met: Greek & Roman Art with Ms Laura (Grade 3 and up) Learn about the famous art and artifacts on display at the Metropolitan Museum of Art in NYC. Each session will focus on examples from a particular wing of the Met. Create your own masterpieces using inspiration from these famous works!

4:00-5:30 World of Color with Ms Carmella (Grade K-2)- Meets 4 times: No class Oct 12
There's a great big world out there! Explore the world through color, texture and medium in this EPIC painting class!

12:30-2:00 Painting Experiments with Ms Elizabeth (Age 4-6) Why not? Have fun experimenting with different paints and effects. In this class we will use a variety of media to explore the idea of using colors and media where we least expect it. It will be fun, colorful and the results will be, well...unexpected.

4:00-5:30 Great Paint Adventure with Ms Carmella (Grade K-2)- Meets 4 times: No class Oct 13 Let's make great looking paintings using a variety of paints: watercolor, tempera, acrylic and even ink. We will mix colors and even combine different kinds of paint to create amazing, colorful paintings.

4:00-5:30 Inktastic Drawings with Mr Doug (Grade 3 and up) In this class we will create ink drawings on paper. Our subject matter may include anything! Learn to see the fine details in every drawing as we create these beautiful black and white and shades of gray ink drawings.

9:00-10:30 Messy Masterpieces with Ms Carmella (Age 4-6) Meets 4 times: No class

11:00-12:30 Pokemon Cartooning with Mr Doug (Grade 3 and up) Create fun comics and comic-style art based on your favorite Pokemon, Minecraft or other cartoon characters. Create a comic page or scene featuring your choice of characters, as you learn techniques in drawing, inking, and lettering. All materials included.

1:00-2:30 Teen Cartoon Studio with Mr Doug (Grade 6 and up) Take your cartooning to the next level with these advanced techniques in line work, values, cartooning from photos, and lettering. 1:00-2:30 Clay Creations with Ms Carmella (Grade 3 +)- Meets 4 times: No class Oct 7

Create beautiful and exciting projects in hand built clay including animals, vessels, tiles and more! Animals, Birds, Insects, Fruits, Vegetables, or Ordinary Everyday Life Objects, can be created in clay! Have fun exploring the possibilities. Students will learn how to sculpt in terra cotta clay. Both directed projects and experimentation will be supported and encouraged as your child's skill evolves. Pieces will be kiln fired and finished with glazes, oxides or paint.
