

Class Descriptions

Week 1: Elements of Art

Ages 4-6

Paint and clay- This class provides a great opportunity for students to try multiple mediums of art. In this week long class students will not only create beautiful paintings around the world but a 3D clay project to give them a well rounded experience.

The Art of Patterns- This class will teach kids how to use repeating shapes and colors to create beautiful, fun designs. Students will explore how to fill their artwork with rhythm and movement, and they'll learn how different patterns can tell a story or create fun effects. A perfect way to get young artists thinking outside the box!

Simple Line Landscapes- is designed to teach students the fundamentals of creating landscape scenes using only lines. This class typically focuses on techniques that simplify natural environments into expressive line work.

Ages 7+

Print' n Paint- Learn to paint while using interesting tools to create texture within the piece and practice sensory skills. This class is different from our traditional painting classes as our focus is on the printing element.

Watercolor and Ink Illustrations- Learn how to apply ink as an element of design within your paintings to create whimsical pieces. This class will have a strong emphasis on drawing before moving on to the exciting medium of watercolor.

Large scale paintings- In this exciting class, kids will learn how to create a large-scale painting from start to finish, using easy-to-follow, step-by-step instructions. Whether you're painting a bold landscape, a colorful abstract, or a favorite animal, this class is all about working big and having fun with paint, brushes, and creativity!

Ages 10+

Textured Paintings- Creating a textured surface to paint on can make the work more engaging and dynamic for viewers. With different techniques to explore this class will be fun and leave students inspired for their own work!

Clay Studio- Get your hands in the clay and let your imagination run wild! In this Teen Clay Studio class, you'll dive into the exciting world of ceramic art, learning how to sculpt, mold, and create with clay. Whether you're interested in functional pottery, abstract sculptures, or decorative pieces, this class is the perfect place to experiment and develop your skills in a fun and creative environment.

Reverse Portrait Collage- Lets learn what it takes to make a self portrait in reverse. This is a great technique for young students to understand the concepts of painting and drawing in a step by step class.
