Week Eight Class Descriptions

Art Around the World- Capture the beauty of beaches or the peaks of mountains as we take a virtual art tour of vacation spots around the world. Brightly colored beach balls, or downhill ski slopes may appear in our art getaway drawings and paintings! Aboriginal Art from Australia, Mosaics from Mexico and more! A variety of painting and mixed media will be used.

Art Jamboree: Draw and paint while appreciating music. Move your brushes and pencils to the feeling of the sounds of different music. What artistic scenes do different styles of music inspire?

Avengers Cartooning Come ready to explore and create comic strips and cartoon stories with themes you love: Minecraft, Star Wars, Avengers, Manga or your own stories. Classes will cover drawing, inking, lettering and coloring your comic stories and art. We will let our imaginations soar as we create cartoon illustrations of our all time favorites!

Barnyard Buddies in Clay- Build a barn and some mini animals in our clay studio! Hand building and pinch pot methods will be used to create an adorable farm scene from terra cotta clay.

Clay Tile and Initial - Enjoy the process of sculpting in clay, but create something beautiful for your walls. Hand-build tiles and other terra cotta wall hangings. Will be painted with underglazes. Art pieces will be kiln fired and ready to hang. Give special letters and the initials of your name all the glory and have a fabulous time using a variety of medias to create and embellish mixed media monogram art!

Digitize Your Design- Are you a future graphic artist/designer? Do you have fun illustrating books, designing web pages & seeing your work in print or online? We explore the tools and knowledge to explore the wonderful world of Graphic Art. Each student will also be introduced to how to create, share & view their artwork for both web and print media. Using an iPad Pro, stylus, and tools from various art software, students learn art techniques that show why the world of digital art takes creative expression to a new level.

Draw What You See- Students will be guided in sharpening their skills drawing still life objects, shading, and depicting 3D objects and people from photos. A great class for beginners and experienced artists who want to improve their observational and drawing abilities.

Funky Forest Friends - Draw and paint daytime Forest animals in the bright sunny sky and nocturnal Forest animals in the deep dark night.

Great Paint Adventure: Let's make great looking paintings using a variety of paints: watercolor, tempera, acrylic and even ink. We will mix colors and even combine different kinds of paint to create amazing, colorful paintings.

It's A Jungle In Here (Clay) - Create beautiful and exciting Jungle animals in clay. Jaguars, birds and snakes all make perfect subjects for this terra cotta clay building class. Students will learn coil and pinch pot techniques to sculpt their perfect jungle friend!

Learn to Embroider - Learn the basics of embroidery with Karen. Simple and complex stitches will combine to create awesome art on fabric! All supplies included. No experience required.

Mosaic Lantern- Colored transparent glass is cut and adhered to the outside of a standing glass lantern then grouted to create a backlit, stained glass lantern. Pillar candle or battery operated candle recommended, but not included.

“Ojo de Dios” Weaving- Learn about the magic of stick weaving as you create your own “Ojo de Dios” or Eye of God weaving. Using yarn and sticks, create a good luck charm that looks cool too!

POP Art- Using works from Andy Warhol, Pablo Picasso (and others) as our inspiration we will create our own works of art using brush and ink, and a variety of painting mediums. These abstract and pop art works will be filled with bold images and colors!

Sculpey Clay Creations- Use air dry clay to create beautiful and functional pieces. Earrings, bowls, keychains and more!

Something to "Sea": Under the sea from A to Z, we'll study a different ocean animal in every class! From tiny sea horses to giant whales, learn about marine life as we use pencils and paints and mixed-media to create artistic masterpieces of our earth's underwater wonderland.
